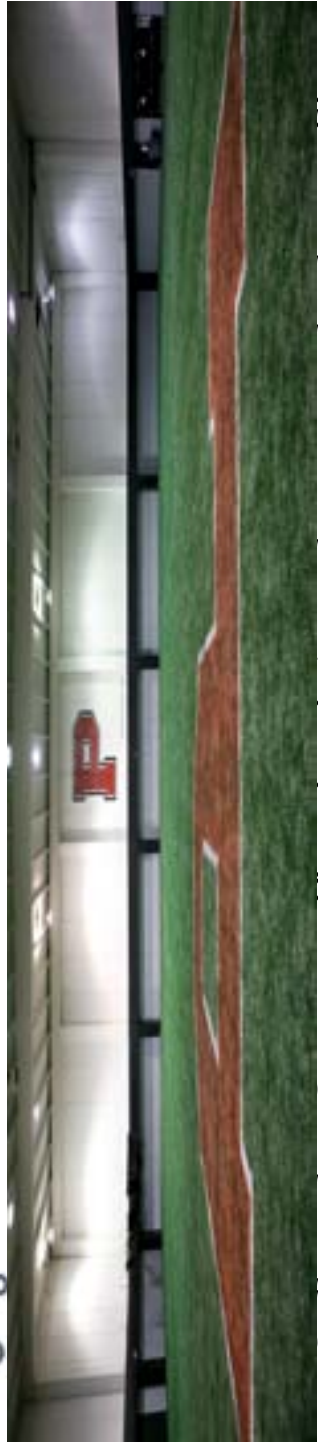

Kids Holiday Instructional Camp

(Ages 6-14) December 19-20, 2011

Kids Camp Info:

Pacific University Baseball is excited to offer an expanded version of its annual youth baseball camp for the 2011 Holiday Season. Participants will first



be grouped by age, ability, and prior experiences. During the morning session throughout the two-day session, participants will be coached in several baseball skills, fundamentals, and team concepts. Members of the camp will receive instruction in a variety of areas including hitting, infield play, outfield play, pitching, catching, rundowns, double

plays and base running. In the afternoon, players will use instruction received during the morning session and put skills to use in game situations in the newly-renovated Indoor Field house Facility. Each team will play together for the duration of the camp week and will be coached by a hand-picked member of our camp staff.

Pacific seeks a low coach to camper ratio to preserve its family-type setting. This Holiday session will be held at the Stoller Center's newly-renovated Indoor Facility on the Pacific University campus in Forest Grove. The main goal is for every player to have an enjoyable and positive learning experience.

About the Stoller Indoor Facility:

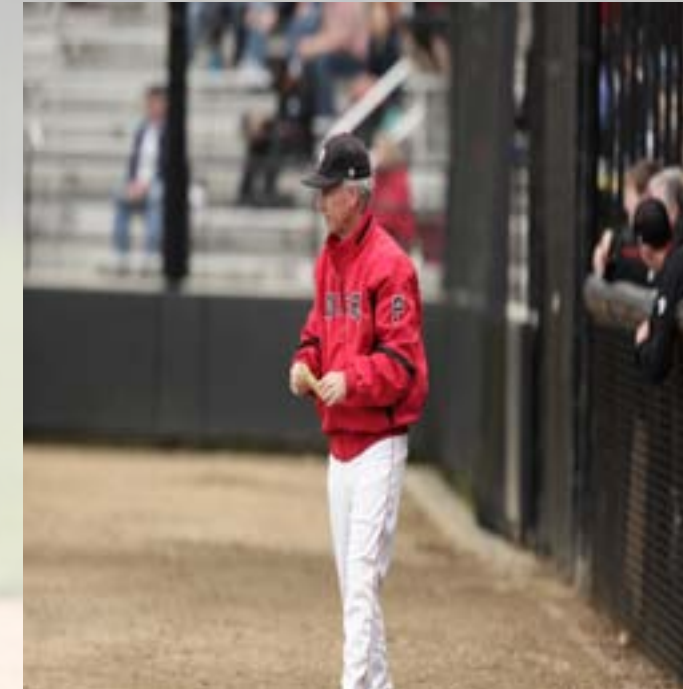
All sessions will be held in the Stoller Athletic Center Indoor Turf Facility which just received a major renovation and upgrade within the last several weeks. The FieldTurf surface in the field house is the newest addition in Pacific's athletics facilities over the last five years. The University spent over \$86,000 for the installation of the artificial surface, nearly \$54,000 of which came from a special fundraising appeal at this year's Pacific University Legends Golf Classic. According to Pacific Director of Athletics Ken Schumann, the University is the only NCAA Division III program in the west, and just one of a handful in the nation, that has an indoor artificial surface of this size. The facility is one of three of its size in the State of Oregon (Oregon and Oregon State). Camp participants will be able to conduct live defensive and offensive drills on a full baseball diamond for the duration of the clinics in the new indoor facility, creating an environment for optimum learning and skills development.

What to bring:

Campers are asked to bring appropriate baseball attire and equipment including: plastic cleats or tennis shoes (no metal cleats allowed), baseball pants, hat, glove, bat, catcher's gear (if applicable) and helmet (if available).

Lunch:

Campers may bring their own lunch or purchase a lunch for \$10 for the duration of camp on the first day.
